A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending sections 16511 and 16521 (MCL 333.16511 and 333.16521), as added by 2006 PA 30.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 16511. (1) Except as otherwise provided under subsection
- 2 (2), after rules are promulgated under section 16145, an individual
- 3 shall not use the -title WORDS, TITLES, OR LETTERS
- 4 "acupuncturist", "certified acupuncturist", or "registered
- 5 acupuncturist", OR A COMBINATION THEREOF, WITH OR WITHOUT
- 6 QUALIFYING WORDS OR PHRASES, unless he or she is registered under
- 7 this part.

- 2 (a) A physician who is licensed under part 170 or 175.
- 3 (b) An individual who is certified by the national acupuncture

- 5 Sec. 16521. (1) The Michigan board of acupuncture is created

- 7 members who meet the requirements of part 161:
- 8 (a) Four acupuncturists. The members initially appointed under

- 10 (b) Three physicians licensed under part 170 or 175.
