(MCL 168.1 to 168.992) by adding section 496a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 496A. (1) A PERSON MAY PREREGISTER TO VOTE AT A SECRETARY
- 2 OF STATE OFFICE IF HE OR SHE MEETS ALL OF THE FOLLOWING
- 3 REQUIREMENTS:
- 4 (A) IS AT LEAST 16 YEARS OF AGE BUT LESS THAN 18 YEARS OF AGE.
- 5 (B) HAS BEEN ISSUED EITHER A GRADUATED LICENSING STATUS TO
- 6 OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE UNDER SECTION 310E OF THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE
- 7 CODE, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.310E, OR AN OFFICIAL STATE PERSONAL
- IDENTIFICATION CARD UNDER 1972 PA 222, MCL 28.291 TO 28.300.
 - (C) IS A CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES.

- 1 (D) HAS BEEN A RESIDENT OF THIS STATE FOR NOT LESS THAN 30
- 2 DAYS.
- 3 (2) A PERSON SHALL PREREGISTER TO VOTE ON A FORM PRESCRIBED BY
- 4 THE SECRETARY OF STATE.
- 5 (3) A PERSON WHO PREREGISTERS TO VOTE UNDER SUBSECTION (1)
- 6 SHALL BE AUTOMATICALLY REGISTERED TO VOTE ON HIS OR HER EIGHTEENTH
- 7 BIRTHDAY.
- 8 (4) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL ADD THE REQUIRED VOTER
- 9 REGISTRATION INFORMATION AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 5090 TO THE
- 10 QUALIFIED VOTER FILE FOR EACH PERSON WHO IS AUTOMATICALLY
- 11 REGISTERED TO VOTE UNDER SUBSECTION (3). THE SECRETARY OF STATE
- 12 SHALL ALSO TRANSMIT THE VOTER REGISTRATION INFORMATION TO THE CLERK
- 13 OF THE CITY, TOWNSHIP, OR VILLAGE WHERE THE VOTER RESIDES.
- 14 (5) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL SEND A NOTICE TO EACH
- 15 PREREGISTERED VOTER ON HIS OR HER EIGHTEENTH BIRTHDAY CONFIRMING
- 16 HIS OR HER ELIGIBILITY TO VOTE.
- 17 (6) IF A NOTICE SENT UNDER SUBSECTION (5) IS RETURNED TO THE
- 18 SECRETARY OF STATE AS UNDELIVERABLE, THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL
- 19 IMMEDIATELY CANCEL THE VOTER REGISTRATION FOR THAT VOTER.
