

# HOUSE BILL No. 6524

September 14, 2006, Introduced by Reps. Ball, Nitz, Proos, Moore, Meyer and Stahl and referred to the Committee on Agriculture.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," (MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding section 5519.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           SEC. 5519. (1) WITHIN 2 YEARS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE  
2 AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL  
3 PROMULGATE RULES SETTING FORTH SEPARATE EMISSION STANDARDS TO BE  
4 MET BY EACH OF THE FOLLOWING:

5           (A) WOOD PELLET STOVES.

6           (B) CORN STOVES.

7           (C) MULTIPLE FUEL STOVES.

8           (2) A PERSON WHO INSTALLS A STOVE THAT, AT THE TIME OF  
9 INSTALLATION, DOES NOT MEET EMISSION STANDARDS PROMULGATED UNDER  
10 SUBSECTION (1), OR WHO OPERATES SUCH A STOVE, IS RESPONSIBLE FOR A

1 STATE CIVIL INFRACTION AND MAY BE ORDERED TO PAY A CIVIL FINE AS  
2 FOLLOWS:

3 (A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBDIVISION (B), \$5,000.00 FOR EACH  
4 DAY OF VIOLATION.

5 (B) IF THE PERSON IS AN INDIVIDUAL AND THE STOVE IS LOCATED IN  
6 THE INDIVIDUAL'S RESIDENCE, \$2,500.00 FOR EACH DAY OF VIOLATION.

7 (3) VIOLATIONS DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (2) ARE NOT SUBJECT TO  
8 SECTION 5529, 5530(2), OR 5531, EXCEPT FOR SECTION 5531(2) AND  
9 (10).

10 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect  
11 unless Senate Bill No.\_\_\_\_ or House Bill No. 6523(request no.  
12 07312'06) of the 93rd Legislature is enacted into law.
