

# SENATE BILL No. 288

March 8, 2005, Introduced by Senators OLSHOVE, JACOBS, CHERRY, KUIPERS, PATTERSON, ALLEN, BERNERO, SWITALSKI, JELINEK, SCHAUER and HARDIMAN and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled  
"The revised school code,"  
(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1310b.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           SEC. 1310B. (1) THE BOARD OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT OR INTERMEDIATE  
2 SCHOOL DISTRICT OR BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF A PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY,  
3 OR THE SCHOOL DISTRICT SUPERINTENDENT, A SCHOOL BUILDING PRINCIPAL,  
4 OR ANOTHER SCHOOL OFFICIAL IF DESIGNATED BY THE BOARD OR BOARD OF  
5 DIRECTORS, MAY AUTHORIZE OR ORDER THE SUSPENSION OR EXPULSION FROM  
6 SCHOOL OF A PUPIL WHO IS CONVICTED OF POSSESSING OR SELLING A  
7 CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE OR CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE ANALOGUE, WHETHER THE  
8 ACTIVITY OCCURRED ON OR OFF SCHOOL PROPERTY, IF, IN THE JUDGMENT OF  
9 THE BOARD OR BOARD OF DIRECTORS OR ITS DESIGNEE, THE INTEREST OF

1 THE SCHOOL IS SERVED BY THE AUTHORIZATION OR ORDER.

2 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE" AND

3 "CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE ANALOGUE" MEAN THOSE TERMS AS DEFINED IN

4 SECTION 7104 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH CODE, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.7104.
