SENATE BILL No. 483

May 10, 2005, Introduced by Senators KUIPERS, GILBERT, BARCIA, CASSIS, GOSCHKA and SANBORN and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 16401 (MCL 333.16401), as amended by 2002 PA 734.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 16401. (1) As used in this part:
 - (a) "Chiropractor", "chiropractic physician", "doctor of chiropractic", or "d.c." means an individual licensed under this article to engage in the practice of chiropractic.
 - (b) "Practice of chiropractic" means that discipline within the healing arts which deals with the human nervous system and <u>its</u> relationship to the spinal column and its THE MUSCULOSKELETAL

- 1 SYSTEM AND THEIR interrelationship with other body systems.
- 2 Practice of chiropractic includes the following:
- 3 (i) Diagnosis, including spinal analysis, **DIFFERENTIAL**
- 4 DIAGNOSIS to determine the existence of spinal subluxations or
- 5 misalignments that produce nerve interference OR JOINT DYSFUNCTION,
- 6 indicating the necessity for chiropractic care THROUGH EXAMINATION,
- 7 EVALUATION, X-RAY AND OTHER IMAGING TECHNOLOGY, AND MONITORING BODY
- 8 PHYSIOLOGY.
- 9 (ii) -A THE chiropractic adjustment of spinal AND EXTRASPINAL
- 10 subluxations or misalignments, -and THE TREATMENT OF related bones
- 11 and tissues THAT PRODUCE JOINT DYSFUNCTION, THE PROVISION OF
- 12 NUTRITIONAL ADVICE, AND THE PERFORMANCE OF PHYSICAL MEDICINE AND
- 13 REHABILITATIVE SERVICES, for the establishment of neural integrity
- 14 AND STRUCTURAL STABILITY utilizing the inherent recuperative powers
- 15 of the body for restoration and maintenance of health.
- 16 (iii) The use of analytical instruments -, nutritional advice,
- 17 rehabilitative exercise and adjustment apparatus regulated by
- 18 rules promulgated by the board pursuant to section 16423. -, and
- 19 the use of x-ray machines in the examination of patients for the
- 20 purpose of locating spinal subluxations or misaligned vertebrae of
- 21 the human spine. The practice of chiropractic does not include the
- 22 performance of incisive surgical procedures -, the performance of
- 23 an invasive procedure requiring instrumentation, or the dispensing
- 24 or prescribing of drugs or medicine.
- 25 (2) In addition to the definitions in this part, article 1
- 26 contains general definitions and principles of construction
- 27 applicable to all articles in this code and part 161 contains
