December 1, 2005, Introduced by Senators ALLEN, TOY and BIRKHOLZ and referred to the Committee on Commerce and Labor.

A bill to require departments and regulatory agencies of this state to acknowledge timely receipt of information requests submitted by mail as the postmark date; and to provide for rule-making authority.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
 "postmark acknowledgment act".
- 3 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
 - (a) "Information submission" means information required to be submitted by a regulated person to a regulatory agency through use of the United States postal service.

- 1 (b) "Regulated person" means an individual or legal entity
- 2 subject to the authority of a regulatory agency.
- 3 (c) "Regulatory agency" means a department, bureau, or agency
- 4 of this state that has statutory regulatory authority over
- 5 activities of an individual, business, profession, or industry.
- 6 Sec. 3. Except as otherwise provided for by law or as
- 7 otherwise required by a rule promulgated before the effective date
- 8 of this act, a regulatory agency shall accept and acknowledge the
- 9 postmark date as the date of receipt of an information submission
- 10 made by a regulated person.
- 11 Sec. 4. Except as otherwise provided for by law, a regulatory
- 12 agency may promulgate rules or amend existing rules under the
- administrative procedures act of 1969, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201 to
- 14 24.328, to implement this act.
- Sec. 5. This act takes effect October 1, 2006.
