

SENATE BILL No. 1100

February 28, 2006, Introduced by Senator JELINEK and referred to the Committee on Economic Development, Small Business and Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1965 PA 285, entitled
"Private detective license act,"
by amending section 5 (MCL 338.825), as amended by 2002 PA 474.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 5. (1) The department, upon application and after making
2 a determination that the applicant is qualified, shall issue the
3 applicant a license to conduct business as a private detective or
4 private investigator for a period of 3 years from date of issuance.

5 (2) Upon the issuance of a license under this act to conduct
6 business as a private detective or private investigator, the
7 applicant is not required to obtain any other license from any
8 municipality or political subdivision of this state. **HOWEVER, A**

1 LICENSEE SHALL NOTIFY, IN WRITING OR BY ELECTRONIC MAIL, THE LAW
2 ENFORCEMENT AGENCY HAVING JURISDICTION OVER A MUNICIPALITY OR
3 POLITICAL SUBDIVISION WHENEVER THE LICENSEE IS CONDUCTING BUSINESS
4 AS A PRIVATE DETECTIVE OR PRIVATE INVESTIGATOR WITHIN THAT
5 MUNICIPALITY OR POLITICAL SUBDIVISION.
