

SENATE BILL No. 1117

March 2, 2006, Introduced by Senators GILBERT, BIRKHOLZ and KUIPERS and referred to the Committee on Families and Human Services.

A bill to amend 1975 PA 238, entitled
"Child protection law,"
by amending section 8b (MCL 722.628b), as amended by 1998 PA 484.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 8b. (1) If a central registry case involves a child's
2 death, serious physical injury of a child, or sexual abuse or
3 exploitation of a child, the department shall refer the case to the
4 prosecuting attorney for the county in which the child is located.
5 The prosecuting attorney shall review the investigation of the case
6 to determine if the investigation complied with the protocol
7 adopted as required by section 8.

8 (2) IF A CENTRAL REGISTRY CASE INVOLVES A CHILD'S EXPOSURE TO

1 OR CONTACT WITH METHAMPHETAMINE PRODUCTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
2 REFER THE CASE TO THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY FOR THE COUNTY IN WHICH
3 THE CHILD IS LOCATED. THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY SHALL REVIEW THE
4 INVESTIGATION OF THE CASE TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE INVESTIGATION
5 COMPLIED WITH THE PROTOCOL ADOPTED AS REQUIRED BY SECTION 8.
