

SENATE BILL No. 1319

June 20, 2006, Introduced by Senators GEORGE, ALLEN, HAMMERSTROM and GOSCHKA and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled
"Revised judicature act of 1961,"
(MCL 600.101 to 600.9947) by adding section 1350c.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 1350C. JURORS IMPANELED AT ANY TRIAL MAY DISCUSS EVIDENCE
2 AND TESTIMONY PRESENTED AT THAT TRIAL BEFORE THE TRIAL CONCLUDES,
3 BUT ONLY WHEN THE COURT IS IN RECESS. THIS SECTION ONLY ALLOWS
4 DISCUSSION AMONG JURORS SERVING ON THE SAME JURY PANEL, AND DOES
5 NOT PERMIT ANY OF THOSE JURORS TO DISCUSS THAT EVIDENCE OR
6 TESTIMONY WITH ANY OTHER INDIVIDUAL.
