<ol> <li>Veterans Service Organization (VSO) Grants. The Governor recommended continuation of VSO grants at current FY08 appropriated level of \$3,912,300.</li> </ol>	0
<ol> <li>Maintenance Equipment. The Governor included Federal funds for the purchase of heavy equipment to be used for maintenance at the Camp Grayling and Fort Custer military training sites.</li> </ol>	400,000
<ol> <li>Military Retirement. The Governor added GF/GP funds to pay for anticipated payments to retired Michigan Army and Air National Guard per P.A. 150 of 1967.</li> </ol>	169,500
<ol> <li>Starbase Program. The Governor included additional Federal funds for science-related elementary school education program to provide training for Starbase directors from around the country.</li> </ol>	815,000
<ol> <li>Headquarters Maintenance. The Governor added GF/GP for utilities and grounds maintenance at the Baker-Olin Building and the Joint Forces Headquarters located in north Lansing.</li> </ol>	200,000
<ol> <li>Human Resource Consolidation. The Department's HR responsibilities, including 9.0 FTEs and \$766,700 GF/GP, were transferred to the Civil Service Commission within the Department of Management and Budget per Executive Order 2007-30.</li> </ol>	(922,300)
<ol> <li>Human Resource Optimization. The HR optimization costs (all GF/GP) previously contained in the Department's budget were transferred to the Civil Service Commission within the Department of Management and Budget.</li> </ol>	(62,600)
<ol> <li>Internal Audit Consolidation. The Department's internal audit responsibilities, including 1.0 FTE, were transferred to the Department of Management and Budget per Executive Order 2007-31.</li> </ol>	0
<ol> <li>Information Technology. The Governor applied a 5% administrative reduction, including a GF/GP reduction of \$600.</li> </ol>	(1,700)
10. <b>Economic Adjustments.</b> The Governor's overall economic adjustments included \$194,500 GF/GP and \$2,200 GF/GP for DIT.	360,100

## **Deleted Boilerplate Sections**

- 1. **Privatization**. Required privatization plan notice. (Sec. 207)
- 2. Report Requirements. Required Department to create and retain reports. (Sec. 211)
- 3. **Armory Closing or Consolidation.** Required consultation with Legislature prior to armory closing or consolidation. (Sec. 213)
- 4. **State Cemeteries.** Required Department to fund State military cemeteries in Crawford and Dickinson Counties should legislation and funding permit their construction (Sec. 214)
- 5. **Disciplinary Action.** Prohibited disciplinary action against employee for communicating with the Legislature. (Sec. 226)
- 6. Sale of Property. Required 60-day notification prior to the sale of Department property. (Sec. 227)
- 7. Efficiency Report. Required an efficiency report to the Legislature. (Sec. 231)
- 8. Armory Rental. Allowed for rental fees of Armories and equipment. (Sec. 301)
- 9. **Veterans Homes' Expenditures.** Prohibited expenditure for anything other than for veterans and veterans' families. (Sec. 601)
- 10. Veterans Homes' Report. Required annual report of State veterans' homes. (Sec. 602)
- 11. **Post, Posthumous Funds.** Language requiring 30-day notification prior to the Department altering the spending plan of the Board of Managers at a veteran's home. (Sec 604)
- 12. County Counselor Assistance. Required steps to assist county veterans' counselors to obtain training. (Sec. 704)

## **Amended Boilerplate Sections**

- 13. **Challenge Program.** The Governor added a requirement that efforts be made to insure at least 75% of the program participants are from families at or below 200% of the Federal poverty level. (Sec. 302)
- 14. Veterans Service Organization Grants. The Governor deleted an efficiency report requirement. (Sec.501)
