

SUBSTITUTE FOR
HOUSE BILL NO. 6715

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled
"Natural resources and environmental protection act,"
(MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding sections 17325 and 17329.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 17325. (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADMINISTER AND ENFORCE
2 THIS PART TO THE EXTENT THAT FUNDS ARE APPROPRIATED FOR THAT
3 PURPOSE.

4 (2) THE DEPARTMENT MAY INSPECT THE OPERATIONS OF A RECYCLER OF
5 COVERED ELECTRONIC DEVICES TO ASSESS COMPLIANCE WITH REQUIREMENTS
6 OF THIS PART.

7 SEC. 17329. (1) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS PART MAY BE ORDERED
8 TO PAY A CIVIL FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$500.00 FOR THE FIRST
9 VIOLATION OR NOT MORE THAN \$2,500.00 FOR A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT
10 VIOLATION.

1 (2) A PERSON WHO KNOWINGLY VIOLATES THIS PART OR WHO KNOWINGLY
2 SUBMITS FALSE INFORMATION TO THE DEPARTMENT UNDER THIS PART IS
3 GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN
4 \$5,000.00. EACH DAY ON WHICH A VIOLATION DESCRIBED IN THIS
5 SUBSECTION OCCURS REPRESENTS A SEPARATE VIOLATION.

6 (3) AFTER A CONTESTED CASE HEARING, THE DEPARTMENT MAY SUSPEND
7 OR REVOKE THE REGISTRATION OF A RECYCLER THAT VIOLATES THIS PART A
8 THIRD OR SUBSEQUENT TIME. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE NOTICE OF
9 THE SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION ON ITS WEBSITE.

10 (4) A CIVIL FINE COLLECTED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE
11 DEPOSITED IN THE ELECTRONIC WASTE RECYCLING FUND CREATED IN SECTION
12 17327.

13 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
14 unless all of the following bills of the 94th Legislature are
15 enacted into law:
