## SUBSTITUTE FOR

## SENATE BILL NO. 1129

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 811e (MCL 257.811e), as amended by 2006 PA 562, and by adding section 811r.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 811e. (1) Beginning January 1, 2007, the THE secretary of
- 2 state may develop a fund-raising plate as provided in this section.
- 3 (2) A start-up fee of \$15,000.00 shall be paid for any new
- 4 fund-raising plate authorized under this section, which fee shall
- 5 be deposited in the transportation administration collection fund
- 6 to be used for the cost of creating, producing, and issuing fund-
- 7 raising plates. If the fee described in this subsection is not paid
- 8 within 18 months of AFTER the effective date of the public act that
- 9 authorizes the development and issuance of a fund-raising plate,

- 1 then—the related fund-raising plate shall not be created, produced,
- 2 or issued. A start-up fee paid under this subsection is
- 3 nonrefundable.
- 4 (3) Not less than 3 years after the secretary of state first
- 5 issues 1 of the fund-raising plates as described in subsection (1)
- 6 and upon payment of \$2,000.00, the Michigan university or other
- 7 person sponsoring that fund-raising plate may redesign it as
- 8 approved by the secretary of state. The payment required under this
- 9 subsection shall be deposited in the transportation administration
- 10 collection fund to be used for the cost of creating, producing, and
- 11 issuing fund-raising plates. A payment under this subsection is
- 12 nonrefundable.
- 13 (4) The secretary of state may develop 1 or more limited term
- 14 registration plates to recognize a Michigan university or an
- 15 accomplishment or occasion of a Michigan university.
- 16 (5) The secretary of state may , at any 1 time, develop not
- 17 more than 8 different state sponsored fund-raising registration
- 18 plates as described in this section, and matching state-sponsored
- 19 collector plates as described in section 811g.
- 20 (6) The secretary of state shall not develop or issue a fund-
- 21 raising plate unless a public act authorizing the fund-raising
- 22 plate, at a minimum, does all of the following:
- 23 (a) Identifies the purpose of the fund-raising plate.
- 24 (b) Creates a nonprofit fund or designates an existing
- 25 nonprofit fund to receive the money raised through the sale of
- 26 fund-raising plates and matching collector plates.
- (c) If a fund is created, names the person or entity

- 1 responsible for administering the fund.
- 2 SEC. 811R. (1) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL DEVELOP UNDER
- 3 SECTION 811E AND ISSUE UNDER SECTION 811F A FUND-RAISING PLATE
- 4 RECOGNIZING RENEWABLE FUEL. THE SECRETARY OF STATE IN CONJUNCTION
- 5 WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE SHALL DESIGN THE FUND-RAISING
- 6 PLATES AUTHORIZED IN THIS SECTION.
- 7 (2) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL TRANSFER THE DONATION MONEY
- 8 FROM THE SALE OF FUND-RAISING PLATES RECOGNIZING RENEWABLE FUEL TO
- 9 THE STATE TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT THE DONATION MONEY TO THE
- 10 RENEWABLE FUEL FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER THE MOTOR FUELS QUALITY ACT,
- 11 1984 PA 44, MCL 290.641 TO 290.650D.
- 12 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 13 unless Senate Bill No. 1130 of the 94th Legislature is enacted into
- **14** law.
