A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 492b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 492B. (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT KNOWINGLY USE A PUBLIC
- 2 RECORD, OR KNOWINGLY USE INFORMATION OBTAINABLE ONLY THROUGH A
- 3 PUBLIC RECORD, TO COMMIT OR ATTEMPT TO COMMIT A CRIME. A PERSON WHO

 - THAN 93 DAYS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$500.00, OR BOTH.

- 9 OF A FELONY PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 5 YEARS OR
