A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 21513 (MCL 333.21513), as amended by 2002 PA 125.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 21513. The owner, operator, and governing body of ahospital licensed under this article:
- (a) Are responsible for all phases of the operation of the
 hospital, selection of the medical staff, and quality of care
 rendered in the hospital.
 - (b) Shall cooperate with the department in the enforcement of this part, and require that the physicians, dentists, and other personnel working in the hospital who are required to be licensed or registered are in fact currently licensed or registered.

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- 1 (c) Shall assure that physicians and dentists admitted to
- 2 practice in the hospital are granted hospital privileges consistent
- 3 with their individual training, experience, and other
- 4 qualifications.
- 5 (d) Shall assure that physicians and dentists admitted to
- 6 practice in the hospital are organized into a medical staff to
- 7 enable an effective review of the professional practices in the
- 8 hospital for the purpose of reducing morbidity and mortality and
- 9 improving the care provided in the hospital for patients. The
- 10 review shall include the quality and necessity of the care provided
- 11 and the preventability of complications and deaths occurring in the
- 12 hospital.
- 13 (e) Shall not discriminate because of race, religion, color,
- 14 national origin, age, or sex in the operation of the hospital
- 15 including employment, patient admission and care, room assignment,
- 16 and professional or nonprofessional selection and training
- 17 programs, and shall not discriminate in the selection and
- 18 appointment of individuals to the physician staff of the hospital
- 19 or its training programs on the basis of licensure or registration
- 20 or professional education as doctors of medicine, osteopathic
- 21 medicine and surgery, or podiatry.
- 22 (f) Shall assure that the hospital adheres to medical control
- 23 authority protocols according to section 20918.
- 24 (g) Shall assure that the hospital develops and maintains a
- 25 plan for biohazard detection and handling.
- 26 (H) SHALL CREATE A LIST OF AT LEAST THE TOP 50 HIGH-VOLUME
- 27 ELECTIVE OR NONEMERGENT INPATIENT AND OUTPATIENT SERVICES PROVIDED

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- 1 BY THE HOSPITAL AND THE AVERAGE CHARGE FOR EACH OF THOSE SERVICES.
- 2 THE LIST CREATED UNDER THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE CONTINUOUSLY
- 3 MAINTAINED, UPDATED, AND POSTED ON THE INTERNET THROUGH THE WEBSITE
- 4 OF THE HOSPITAL, SHALL BE PROVIDED TO INDIVIDUALS SEEKING
- 5 INFORMATION ON THOSE SERVICES, AND SHALL BE PROVIDED IN WRITING
- 6 UPON REQUEST.
