A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

by amending section 50b (MCL 750.50b), as amended by 1996 PA 80.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 50b. (1) As used in this section, "animal" means any
 vertebrate other than a human being.
