HOUSE BILL No. 4874

June 5, 2007, Introduced by Rep. Amos and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 59, entitled

"Condominium act,"

by amending sections 8, 37, and 69 (MCL 559.108, 559.137, and 559.169), section 8 as amended by 1982 PA 538 and section 69 as amended by 2002 PA 283.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 8. (1) "Master deed" means the condominium document
- 2 recording the condominium project to which are attached as exhibits
- 3 and incorporated by reference the bylaws for the project and the
- 4 condominium subdivision plan for the project. The master deed shall
- include all of the following:
 - (a) An accurate legal description of the land involved in the project.
 - (b) A statement designating the condominium units served by

- 1 the limited common elements and clearly defining the rights in the
- 2 limited common elements.
- 3 (c) A statement showing the total percentage of value for the
- 4 condominium project and the separate percentages of values assigned
- 5 to each individual condominium unit identifying the condominium
- 6 units by the numbers assigned in the condominium subdivision plan.
- 7 (d) Identification of the local unit of government with which
- 8 the detailed architectural plans and specifications for the project
- 9 have been filed.
- 10 (e) Any other matter which is appropriate for the project.
- 11 (2) BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2008, NO MASTER DEED CREATED ON OR
- 12 AFTER THAT DATE THAT PURPORTS TO ALLOCATE CONDOMINIUM MAINTENANCE
- 13 FEES TO CO-OWNERS SHALL ALLOCATE CONDOMINIUM MAINTENANCE FEES TO
- 14 OWNERS ON ANY BASIS OTHER THAN A PER-SQUARE-FOOT OWNERSHIP BASIS.
- 15 Sec. 37. (1) The master deed may allocate to each condominium
- 16 unit an undivided interest in the common elements proportionate to
- 17 its percentage of value assigned as provided in this act.
- 18 (2) If an equal percentage of value is allocated to each
- 19 condominium unit, the master deed may simply state that fact and
- 20 need not express the fraction or percentage so allocated.
- 21 (3) If an equal percentage of value is not assigned, the
- 22 percentage of value allocated to each condominium unit shall be
- 23 reflected by a table in the master deed or by an exhibit or
- 24 schedule accompanying the master deed and recorded simultaneously
- 25 therewith. The table shall identify the condominium units, listing
- 26 them serially or grouping them together in the case of condominium
- 27 units to which identical percentages of value are allocated, and

- 1 setting forth the respective percentages relative to the several
- 2 condominium units. The master deed or the exhibit or schedule shall
- 3 set forth, with reasonable clarity, the formula upon which the
- 4 percentages were allocated in the original master deed and the
- 5 basis upon which the same will be reallocated in any modification
- 6 of the master deed by which condominium units will be added,
- 7 withdrawn, or modified, which basis may provide for reasonable
- 8 flexibility if different types of condominium units are introduced
- 9 into the condominium project in subsequent phases thereof.
- 10 (4) A convertible space shall be allocated a percentage of
- 11 value in accordance with the formula used to derive the original
- 12 percentage of value.
- 13 (5) Except to the extent otherwise expressly provided by this
- 14 act, the undivided interest in the common elements allocated to any
- 15 condominium unit shall not be altered, and any purported transfer,
- 16 encumbrance, or other disposition of that interest without the
- 17 condominium unit to which it appertains is void.
- 18 (6) The common elements shall not be subject to an action for
- 19 partition unless the condominium project is terminated.
- 20 (7) BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2008, NO MASTER DEED CREATED ON OR
- 21 AFTER THAT DATE THAT PURPORTS TO ALLOCATE CONDOMINIUM MAINTENANCE
- 22 FEES TO CO-OWNERS SHALL ALLOCATE CONDOMINIUM MAINTENANCE FEES TO
- 23 OWNERS ON ANY BASIS OTHER THAN A PER-SQUARE-FOOT OWNERSHIP BASIS.
- 24 Sec. 69. (1) Except to the extent that the condominium
- 25 documents provide otherwise, common expenses associated with the
- 26 maintenance, repair, renovation, restoration, or replacement of a
- 27 limited common element shall be specially assessed against the

- 1 condominium unit to which that limited common element was assigned
- 2 at the time the expenses were incurred. If the limited common
- 3 element involved was assigned to more than 1 condominium unit, the
- 4 expenses shall be specially assessed against each of the
- 5 condominium units equally so that the total of the special
- 6 assessments equals the total of the expenses, except to the extent
- 7 that the condominium documents provide otherwise.
- 8 (2) To the extent that the condominium documents expressly so
- 9 provide, any other unusual common expenses benefiting less than all
- 10 of the condominium units, or any expenses incurred as a result of
- 11 the conduct of less than all those entitled to occupy the
- 12 condominium project or by their licensees or invitees, shall be
- 13 specially assessed against the condominium unit or condominium
- 14 units involved, in accordance with reasonable provisions as the
- 15 condominium documents may provide.
- 16 (3) The EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, THE
- 17 amount of all common expenses not specially assessed under
- 18 subsections (1) and (2) shall be assessed against the condominium
- 19 units in proportion to the percentages of value or other provisions
- 20 as may be contained in the master deed for apportionment of
- 21 expenses of administration.
- 22 (4) A co-owner shall not be exempt from contributing as
- 23 provided in this act by nonuse or waiver of the use of any of the
- 24 common elements or by abandonment of his or her condominium unit.
- 25 (5) BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2008, NO MASTER DEED, LEASE, OR OTHER
- 26 CONDOMINIUM DOCUMENT ENTERED INTO ON OR AFTER THAT DATE SHALL
- 27 ALLOCATE CONDOMINIUM MAINTENANCE FEES TO OWNERS ON ANY BASIS OTHER

1 THAN A PER-SQUARE-FOOT OWNERSHIP BASIS.
