

HOUSE BILL No. 5091

August 8, 2007, Introduced by Rep. Opsommer and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1972 PA 222, entitled

"An act to provide for an official personal identification card; to provide for its form, issuance and use; to regulate the use and disclosure of information obtained from the card; to prescribe the powers and duties of the secretary of state; to prescribe fees; to prescribe certain penalties for violations; and to provide an appropriation for certain purposes,"

(MCL 28.291 to 28.300) by adding section 2a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 **SEC. 2A. (1) AN OFFICIAL STATE PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION CARD**
2 **ISSUED UNDER THIS ACT SHALL NOT CONTAIN EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING:**

3 **(A) A RADIO FREQUENCY IDENTIFICATION DEVICE.**

4 **(B) ANY OTHER DEVICE CAPABLE OF HAVING STORED INFORMATION READ**
5 **BY A REMOTE RECEIVER, IF THE DEVICE AND REMOTE RECEIVER CAN SHARE**
6 **INFORMATION WHEN THEY DO NOT HAVE A CLEAR LINE OF SIGHT BETWEEN**

2 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "RADIO FREQUENCY IDENTIFICATION
3 DEVICE" MEANS AN ELECTRONIC DEVICE THAT STORES INFORMATION AND IS
4 DESIGNED TO TRANSMIT THAT INFORMATION BY MEANS OF RADIO WAVES TO A
5 RECEIVER.
