## **HOUSE BILL No. 5146**

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 9. (1) Except as provided in subsections (2) AND (3),
- 2 and (4), an individual required to be registered under this act who
- 3 willfully violates this act is guilty of a felony punishable as
- 4 follows:
- 5 (a) If the individual has no prior convictions for a violation
