THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 5827. Except as otherwise expressly provided, the period
- 2 of limitations runs from the time the claim accrues. The claim
- 3 accrues at the time provided in sections 5829 to 5838, and 5838A
- 4 OR, in cases not covered by these sections the claim accrues at the
- 5 time the wrong upon which the claim is based was done regardless of
- 6 the time when damage results 5829 TO 5838A, WHEN THE PLAINTIFF
- 7 DISCOVERS OR, THROUGH THE EXERCISE OF REASONABLE DILIGENCE, SHOULD
- 8 HAVE DISCOVERED THE CAUSE OF ACTION AND IS ABLE TO PROPERLY ALLEGE
- 9 THE ELEMENTS OF THE CAUSE OF ACTION IN A COMPLAINT.
