HOUSE BILL No. 6454

September 11, 2008, Introduced by Rep. Hune and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1956 PA 217, entitled "Electrical administrative act,"

by amending sections 1, 8g, and 9 (MCL 338.881, 338.888g, and 338.889), section 1 as amended by 1992 PA 130, section 8g as added by 1990 PA 246, and section 9 as amended by 1981 PA 150.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. (1) For purposes of this act, the words defined in
- 2 this section, section 1a, and section 1b have the meanings ascribed
- 3 to them in those sections.
- 4 (2) "Electrical wiring" means all wiring, generating
 - equipment, fixtures, appliances, and appurtenances in connection
- 6 with the generation, distribution, and utilization of electrical
 - energy, within or on a building, residence, structure, or

- 1 properties, and including service entrance wiring as defined by the
- 2 code.
- 3 (3) "Electrical contractor" means a person, firm, or
- 4 corporation engaged in the business of erecting, installing,
- 5 altering, repairing, servicing, or maintaining electrical wiring,
- 6 devices, appliances, or equipment.
- 7 (4) "Master electrician" means a person having the necessary
- 8 qualifications, training, experience, and technical knowledge to
- 9 supervise the installation of electrical wiring and equipment in
- 10 accordance with the standard rules and regulations governing that
- 11 work.
- 12 (5) "Electrical journeyman" means a person other than an
- 13 electrical contractor who, as his or her principal occupation, is
- 14 engaged in the practical installation or alteration of electric
- 15 wiring. An electrical contractor or master electrician may also be
- 16 an electrical journeyman.
- 17 (6) "Apprentice electrician" means an individual other than an
- 18 electrical contractor, master electrician, or electrical
- 19 journeyman, who is engaged in learning about and assisting in the
- 20 installation or alteration of electrical wiring and equipment under
- 21 the direct personal supervision of an electrical journeyman or
- 22 master electrician.
- 23 (7) "Jobsite" means the immediate work area within the
- 24 property lines of a single construction project, alteration
- 25 project, or maintenance project where electrical construction or
- 26 alteration of electrical wiring is in progress.

- 22 (13) "Board" means the electrical administrative board created
- 23 pursuant to section 2.
- Sec. 8g. Any provision of this act which is inconsistent or in
- 25 conflict with the state construction code act of 1972 STILLE-
- 26 DEROSSETT-HALE SINGLE STATE CONSTRUCTION CODE ACT is superseded to
- 27 the extent of the inconsistency or conflict.
