September 26, 2007, Introduced by Senators SCHAUER, GLEASON, CLARKE, CLARK-COLEMAN, SCOTT, HUNTER and JACOBS and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled
"Revised judicature act of 1961,"
by amending section 5827 (MCL 600.5827).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 5827. Except as otherwise expressly provided, the period
2 of limitations runs from the time the claim accrues. The claim
3 accrues at the time provided in sections 5829 to 5838 ~~, and~~ **OR**, in
4 cases not covered by ~~these sections the claim accrues at the time~~
5 ~~the wrong upon which the claim is based was done regardless of the~~
6 ~~time when damage results~~ **5829 TO 5838, WHEN THE PLAINTIFF DISCOVERS**
7 **OR THROUGH THE EXERCISE OF REASONABLE DILIGENCE SHOULD HAVE**
8 **DISCOVERED THE ELEMENTS OF THE CAUSE OF ACTION, INCLUDING THE**
9 **IDENTITY OF THE DEFENDANT.**

1 Enacting section 1. The provisions added by this amendatory
2 act apply to all causes of action that arise before, on, or after
3 the effective date of this amendatory act.
