SENATE BILL No. 1083

February 5, 2008, Introduced by Senators PATTERSON, BIRKHOLZ and BASHAM and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources and Environmental Affairs.

A bill to amend 1968 PA 191, entitled

"An act to create a state boundary commission; to prescribe its powers and duties; to provide for municipal incorporation, consolidation, and annexation; to prescribe penalties and provide remedies; and to repeal acts and parts of acts,"

by amending section 11b (MCL 123.1011b), as added by 1982 PA 192.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 11b. (1) If the commission, after determining the
- validity of a petition or resolution for annexation, has ordered a
- 3 public hearing pursuant to section 9 of Act No. 279 of the Public

- 5 Compiled Laws THE HOME RULE CITY ACT, 1909 PA 279, MCL 117.9, and
- 6 if on the date the petition or resolution was filed more than 100
- persons resided in the area proposed for annexation, the

- 1 legislative body of each city and township affected by the proposed
- 2 annexation may pass a resolution calling for a referendum on the
- 3 question of annexation. If a copy of each resolution passed by the
- 4 legislative body of each affected city and township is filed with
- 5 the commission and the commission approves the annexation, the
- 6 commission, in its order approving the annexation, shall order that
- 7 a referendum on the question of annexation be held in each affected
- 8 city and township. If a resolution calling for a referendum on the
