## **SENATE BILL No. 1387**

June 17, 2008, Introduced by Senators WHITMER, PAPPAGEORGE, BASHAM, SWITALSKI, KUIPERS, GLEASON and HARDIMAN and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1990 PA 250, entitled "DNA identification profiling system act," by amending section 3a (MCL 28.173a), as added by 2001 PA 88.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 3a. (1) An individual required by law to provide samples 2 for DNA identification profiling who refuses to provide or resists 3 providing those samples is quilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 1 year or a fine of not more than 5 \$1,000.00, or both. The individual shall be advised that his or her resistance or refusal to provide samples described in this subsection is a misdemeanor.
  - (2) If at the time an individual who is required by law to provide samples for DNA identification profiling is convicted the

- 1 investigating law enforcement agency or the department already has
- 2 a sample from the individual that meets the requirements of the
- 3 rules promulgated under this act, the individual is not required to
- 4 provide another sample. HOWEVER, IF AN INDIVIDUAL'S DNA SAMPLE IS
