A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 21525.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 21525. (1) ON OR BEFORE FEBRUARY 1 OF EACH YEAR, EACH
- 2 HOSPITAL SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE DEPARTMENT SUMMARIZING THE
- 3 NUMBER OF HOSPITAL-ACQUIRED INFECTIONS CONTRACTED BY PATIENTS IN
- 4 THE IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING CALENDAR YEAR. THE ANNUAL REPORT SHALL BE
- SUBMITTED ON A FORM AND IN A MANNER AS PRESCRIBED BY THE
- 6 DEPARTMENT. THE DEPARTMENT MAY REQUIRE ANY INFORMATION CONSIDERED
- NECESSARY FOR THE SURVEILLANCE, CONTROL, AND PREVENTION OF
- 8 HOSPITAL-ACQUIRED INFECTIONS.

- 1 (2) THE REPORTING FORM SHALL BREAK DOWN THE NUMBER OF

- 10 SUMMARY OF ALL INFORMATION RECEIVED FROM HOSPITALS UNDER THIS
- 11 SECTION. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL INCLUDE IN THE SUMMARY UNDER THIS
- 12 SUBSECTION INFORMATION REGARDING THE NUMBER OF HOSPITAL-ACQUIRED
- 13 INFECTIONS FOR EACH HOSPITAL AND FOR EACH UNIT OR DEPARTMENT WITHIN
- 14 THAT HOSPITAL. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROMOTE PUBLIC AWARENESS OF AND
- 15 INCREASE KNOWLEDGE ABOUT HOSPITAL-ACQUIRED INFECTIONS AND THE STEPS
- 16 BEING TAKEN BY HOSPITALS TO PREVENT HOSPITAL-ACQUIRED INFECTIONS.
- 17 (4) THE DEPARTMENT MAY PROMULGATE RULES TO PROVIDE FOR THE
- 18 STANDARDS AND PROCEDURES FOR THE COLLECTION, ANALYSIS, AND
- 19 REPORTING UNDER THIS SECTION OF HOSPITAL-ACQUIRED INFECTIONS AND
- 20 FOR THE PRESERVATION OF THE ANONYMITY OF EACH PATIENT WHILE
- 21 REPORTING THE NUMBER OF HOSPITAL-ACQUIRED INFECTIONS TO THE
- 22 DEPARTMENT.
- 23 (5) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "HOSPITAL-ACQUIRED INFECTION"
- 24 MEANS A NOSOCOMIAL INFECTION THAT IS A LOCALIZED OR SYSTEMIC
- 25 CONDITION RESULTING FROM AN ADVERSE REACTION TO THE PRESENCE OF AN
- 26 INFECTIOUS AGENT OR ITS TOXIN AND THAT WAS NOT PRESENT OR
- 27 INCUBATING AT THE TIME A PATIENT WAS ADMITTED TO THE HOSPITAL FOR
