8	Sec. 201. In accordance with the provisions of section 30 of
9	article IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending
10	from state resources in this appropriation act for the fiscal year
11	ending September 30, 2010 is \$0 and state appropriations paid to
12	local units of government are \$0.
13	Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized
14	under this act and the departments, commissions, boards, offices,
15	and programs for which appropriations are made under this act are
16	subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101
17	to 18.1594.
18	Sec. 203. The line-item appropriations in part 1 financed by
19	federal funds designated as ARRA funding represent federal funds
20	associated with the American recovery and reinvestment act of 2009,
21	Public Law 111-5. These federal funds are temporary in nature. It
22	is the intent of the legislature that when these temporary federal
23	funds are fully expended, the program funding levels and any state
24	employees supported by these temporary federal funds will not be
25	continued.

- 1 Sec. 210. (1) In addition to the funds appropriated in part 1,
- 2 there is appropriated an amount equal to any additional federal
- 3 funding awarded to this state through recalculation of formulas and
- 4 under the redistribution provisions of the American recovery and

- 3 to, any certifications, assurances, and accountability and
- 4 transparency provisions required in the American recovery and
- 5 reinvestment act of 2009, Public Law 111-5.

- 7 recipient state departments or agencies in an interdepartmental
- 8 grant consistent with the requirements of the American recovery and
- 9 reinvestment act of 2009, Public Law 111-5.
