## SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 1077

A bill to provide for, and facilitate the providing of, firefighter training programs to certain individuals through sponsors affiliated with certain other entities; and to prescribe standards for examinations.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Affiliated organization" means a school district,
- 3 organized fire department, or other entity.
- 4 (b) "Firefighter" means that term as defined in section 2 of
- 5 the firefighters training council act, 1966 PA 291, MCL 29.362.
- 6 (c) "Firefighter training" means that term as defined in
- 7 section 2 of the firefighters training council act, 1966 PA 291,

- 2 (d) "Organized fire department" means that term as defined in
- 3 section 2 of the firefighters training council act, 1966 PA 291,
- 4 MCL 29.362.
- 5 Sec. 2. (1) An organized fire department administering a fire
- 6 fighter I and II course and an examination under the firefighters
- 7 training council act, 1966 PA 291, MCL 29.361 to 29.377, may
- 8 establish a boy scouts of America explorer post within its
- 9 department for the purpose of firefighter training for individuals
- 10 who are 16 or 17 years of age.
- 11 (2) An affiliated organization that is not an organized fire
- 12 department may affiliate with an organized fire department for the
- 13 purpose of allowing individuals 16 or 17 years of age to
- 14 participate in the fire fighter I and II course and the
- 15 examination.
- 16 Sec. 3. Pursuant to section 1233b of the revised school code,
- 17 1976 PA 451, MCL 380.1233b, the board of a local or intermediate
- 18 school district may apply to the state board of education for a
- 19 permit or annual authorization to engage a full-time or part-time
- 20 noncertificated, nonendorsed teacher to teach fire fighter I and II
- 21 courses and to administer the examination as described in this act.
- 22 Sec. 4. This act does not require the state fire marshal or
- 23 the office of firefighter training to pay or contribute any funds
- 24 for the administration of the course or its examinations described
- 25 in this act that are in addition to any examinations or costs
- 26 already imposed under the firefighters training council act, 1966
- 27 PA 291, MCL 29.361 to 29.377. Any additional costs are to be borne

- by the organized fire department or the individual firefighter 1
- taking the course and examination. 2
