HOUSE BILL No. 4957

May 19, 2009, Introduced by Reps. Espinoza, Terry Brown, Neumann, Polidori and Lori and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled

"Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 811e (MCL 257.811e), as amended by 2006 PA 562, and by adding section 811r.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 811e. (1) Beginning January 1, 2007, the THE secretary of state may develop a fund-raising plate as provided in this section.
 - (2) A start-up fee of \$15,000.00 shall be paid for any new fund-raising plate authorized under this section, which fee shall be deposited in the transportation administration collection fund to be used for the cost of creating, producing, and issuing fund-raising plates. If the fee described in this subsection is not paid within 18 months of AFTER the effective date of the public act that

- 1 authorizes the development and issuance of a fund-raising plate,
- 2 then the related fund-raising plate shall not be created, produced,
- 3 or issued. A start-up fee paid under this subsection is
- 4 nonrefundable.
- 5 (3) Not less than 3 years after the secretary of state first
- 6 issues 1 of the fund-raising plates as described in subsection (1)
- 7 and upon payment of \$2,000.00, the Michigan university or other
- 8 person sponsoring that fund-raising plate may redesign it as
- 9 approved by the secretary of state. The payment required under this
- 10 subsection shall be deposited in the transportation administration
- 11 collection fund to be used for the cost of creating, producing, and
- 12 issuing fund-raising plates. A payment under this subsection is
- 13 nonrefundable.
- 14 (4) The secretary of state may develop 1 or more limited term
- 15 registration plates to recognize a Michigan university or an
- 16 accomplishment or occasion of a Michigan university.
- 17 (5) The secretary of state may, at any 1 time, develop not
- 18 more than 8-9 different state sponsored fund-raising registration
- 19 plates as described in this section, and matching state-sponsored
- 20 collector plates as described in section 811g.
- 21 (6) The secretary of state shall not develop or issue a fund-
- 22 raising plate unless a public act authorizing the fund-raising
- 23 plate, at a minimum, does all of the following:
- 24 (a) Identifies the purpose of the fund-raising plate.
- 25 (b) Creates a nonprofit fund or designates an existing
- 26 nonprofit fund to receive the money raised through the sale of
- 27 fund-raising plates and matching collector plates.

- 1 (c) If a fund is created, names the person or entity
- 2 responsible for administering the fund.
- 3 SEC. 811R. (1) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL DEVELOP UNDER
- 4 SECTION 811E AND ISSUE A THIN BLUE LINE FUND-RAISING PLATE UNDER
- 5 SECTION 811F AND A MATCHING THIN BLUE LINE COLLECTOR PLATE AS
- 6 PROVIDED UNDER SECTION 811G. THE SECRETARY OF STATE IN CONJUNCTION
- 7 WITH THE THIN BLUE LINE OF MICHIGAN SHALL DESIGN THE PLATES, HAVING
- 8 THE WORDS "THIN BLUE LINE" AND "MICHIGAN" ON THE PLATES.
- 9 (2) THE OWNER OF A VEHICLE REQUIRED TO BE REGISTERED UNDER
- 10 THIS ACT MAY APPLY, ON A FORM PRESCRIBED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE,
- 11 FOR A THIN BLUE LINE FUND-RAISING PLATE AS PRESCRIBED IN SECTION
- 12 811F INSTEAD OF A STANDARD REGISTRATION PLATE.
- 13 (3) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL TRANSFER THE DONATION MONEY
- 14 FROM THE SALE OF THIN BLUE LINE FUND-RAISING AND COLLECTOR PLATES
- 15 TO THE STATE TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT THE DONATION MONEY AS
- 16 FOLLOWS:
- 17 (A) \$15.00 TO THE THIN BLUE LINE FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER
- 18 SUBSECTION (4).
- 19 (B) \$5.00 TO THE POLICE OFFICER'S AND FIRE FIGHTER'S SURVIVOR
- 20 TUITION FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION (7).
- 21 (C) \$5.00 TO THE CRIME VICTIM'S RIGHTS FUND CREATED IN SECTION
- 22 4 OF 1989 PA 196, MCL 780.904.
- 23 (4) THE THIN BLUE LINE FUND IS CREATED WITHIN THE STATE
- 24 TREASURY. THE STATE TREASURER MAY RECEIVE MONEY OR OTHER ASSETS
- 25 FROM ANY SOURCE FOR DEPOSIT INTO THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER
- 26 SHALL DIRECT THE INVESTMENT OF THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL
- 27 CREDIT TO THE FUND INTEREST AND EARNINGS FROM FUND INVESTMENTS.

- 1 MONEY IN THE FUND AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR SHALL REMAIN IN
- 2 THE FUND AND SHALL NOT LAPSE TO THE GENERAL FUND.
- 3 (5) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DISBURSE MONEY IN THE FUND ON A
- 4 QUARTERLY BASIS TO THE THIN BLUE LINE OF MICHIGAN, P.O. BOX 415,
- 5 HOWELL, MICHIGAN 48844-0415 OR A SUCCESSOR ADDRESS. BEGINNING NOT
- 6 LATER THAN FEBRUARY 1, 2011, AND ANNUALLY AFTER THAT, AN
- 7 ORGANIZATION RECEIVING MONEY UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL REPORT TO THE
- 8 STATE TREASURER. A REPORT UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL INCLUDE A
- 9 SUMMARY OF EXPENDITURES DURING THE PRECEDING YEAR OF THE MONEY
- 10 RECEIVED UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 11 (6) THE THIN BLUE LINE OF MICHIGAN SHALL EXPEND THE MONEY
- 12 RECEIVED UNDER THIS SECTION SOLELY TO ASSIST AND SUPPORT THE
- 13 FAMILIES OF INJURED OR DECEASED OFFICERS OF LAW ENFORCEMENT
- 14 AGENCIES WITHIN THIS STATE.
- 15 (7) THE POLICE OFFICER'S AND FIRE FIGHTER'S SURVIVOR TUITION
- 16 FUND IS ESTABLISHED WITHIN THE STATE TREASURY. THE STATE TREASURER
- 17 MAY RECEIVE MONEY OR OTHER ASSETS FROM ANY SOURCE FOR DEPOSIT INTO
- 18 THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DIRECT THE INVESTMENT OF THE
- 19 FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL CREDIT TO THE FUND INTEREST AND
- 20 EARNINGS FROM FUND INVESTMENTS. MONEY IN THE FUND AT THE CLOSE OF
- 21 THE FISCAL YEAR SHALL REMAIN IN THE FUND AND SHALL NOT LAPSE TO THE
- 22 GENERAL FUND.
- 23 (8) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DISBURSE MONEY IN THE FUND ON A
- 24 OUARTERLY BASIS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE. BEGINNING NOT
- 25 LATER THAN FEBRUARY 1, 2011, THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE SHALL
- 26 SUBMIT TO THE STATE TREASURER A SUMMARY OF THE EXPENDITURES DURING
- 27 THE PRECEDING YEAR OF THE MONEY RECEIVED UNDER THIS SECTION.

- 1 (9) THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE SHALL EXPEND THE MONEY
- 2 RECEIVED UNDER THIS SECTION SOLELY TO ASSIST AND SUPPORT THE POLICE
- 3 OFFICER'S AND FIRE FIGHTER'S SURVIVOR TUITION ACT, 1996 PA 195, MCL
