A bill to amend 2008 PA 554, entitled "Regional convention facility authority act," by amending section 5 (MCL 141.1355).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 5. As used in this act:
- (a) "Authority" means a regional convention facility authoritycreated under section 7.
 - (b) "Board" means the board of directors of an authority.
 - (c) "Convention facility" means all or any part of, or any combination of, a convention hall, auditorium, arena, meeting rooms, exhibition area, and related adjacent public areas that are generally available to the public for lease on a short-term basis for holding conventions, meetings, exhibits, and similar events,

- 1 together with real or personal property, and easements above, on,
- 2 or under the surface of real or personal property, used or intended
- 3 to be used for holding conventions, meetings, exhibits, and similar

- 1 (i) "Qualified city" means a city with a population of more
- 2 than 700,000 according to the most recent decennial census. that

- 4 (j) "Qualified county" means a county that contains a

- 6 (k) "Qualified convention facility" means a publicly owned
- 7 convention facility with not less than 600,000 square feet of
- 8 usable exhibition area and that is located in a qualified city.
