

HOUSE BILL No. 5696

December 10, 2009, Introduced by Rep. Dillon and referred to the Committee on Public Employee Health Care Reform.

A bill to amend 1967 PA 156, entitled
"Optional retirement act of 1967,"
by amending section 4 (MCL 38.384).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 4. (1) In the administration of the optional retirement
2 program, a board of control shall provide for the purchase of
3 contracts providing retirement and death benefits for or on behalf
4 of eligible employees electing to be covered by the optional
5 retirement program.

6 (2) RETIREMENT HEALTH BENEFITS COVERAGE, IF OFFERED BY THE
7 BOARD, SHALL BE PROVIDED AND AUTHORIZED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE
8 MICHIGAN HEALTH BENEFITS PROGRAM ACT. COVERAGE PROVIDED AND PLANS
9 AUTHORIZED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE MICHIGAN HEALTH BENEFITS PROGRAM
10 ACT SHALL BE PROVIDED AND AUTHORIZED SUBJECT TO SECTION 21 OF THE

1 **MICHIGAN HEALTH BENEFITS PROGRAM ACT.**

2 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
3 unless House Bill No. 5345 of the 95th Legislature is enacted into
4 law.
