by amending section 371 (MCL 18.1371), as amended by 2007 PA 2.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 371. (1) An employee of a state agency shall not make orauthorize an expenditure or incur an obligation that results in the
- 3 agency exceeding the gross appropriation level of an appropriation
- 4 line item made to that agency by the legislature. The chief
- 5 executive officer and the chief financial officer of a state agency
- 6 are responsible for any action taken by a state agency that results
- 7 in exceeding an appropriation. The chief executive officer of a
- 8 state agency shall report a violation of this subsection

- 1 immediately to the director and the chairpersons of the senate and
- 2 house appropriations committees, together with a statement of any
- 3 action taken to remedy the occurrence.
- 4 (2) Within 15 days after a bill appropriating an amount is
- 5 enacted into law, the amount appropriated shall be divided into
- 6 allotments by department and by state agency based on periodic
- 7 requirements to represent a spending plan. The state budget
- 8 director shall review the allotments. Not later than June 1 of each
- 9 year, the director shall submit to the chairpersons of the
- 10 appropriations committees and the fiscal agencies a report that
- 11 provides estimates as to which departments are spending at a rate
- 12 that would exceed the level of the appropriation for the fiscal
- 13 year. This report shall include recommendations as to actions that

- 25 EXPENDITURE OR OBLIGATION WILL RESULT IN THE STATE AGENCY EXCEEDING
- 26 THE GROSS APPROPRIATION LEVEL OF AN APPROPRIATION LINE ITEM MADE TO
- 27 THE STATE AGENCY BY THE LEGISLATURE IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR
