HOUSE BILL No. 6313

July 1, 2010, Introduced by Rep. Lindberg and referred to the Committee on Tourism, Outdoor Recreation and Natural Resources.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled

"Natural resources and environmental protection act,"

by amending sections 80101 and 80104 (MCL 324.80101 and 324.80104), section 80101 as amended by 2004 PA 547 and section 80104 as amended by 2004 PA 587; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 80101. As used in this part:
- 2 (a) "Airboat" means a motorboat that is propelled, wholly or
- 3 in part, by a propeller projecting above the water surface.
- 4 (b) "Anchored rafts" means all types of nonpowered rafts used
- 5 for recreational purposes that are anchored seasonally on waters of
 - this state.
 - (c) "Associated equipment" means any of the following that are
- 8 not radio equipment:

- 1 (i) An original system, part, or component of a boat at the
- 2 time that boat was manufactured, or a similar part or component
- 3 manufactured or sold for replacement.
- 4 (ii) Repair or improvement of an original or replacement
- 5 system, part, or component.
- 6 (iii) An accessory or equipment for, or appurtenance to, a boat.
- 7 (iv) A marine safety article, accessory, or equipment intended
- 8 for use by a person on board a boat.
- 9 (d) "Boat" means a vessel.
- (e) "Boat livery" means a business that holds a vessel for
- 11 renting, leasing, or chartering.
- 12 (F) "BOATING SAFETY CERTIFICATE" MEANS ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 13 (i) THE DOCUMENT ISSUED BY THE DEPARTMENT UNDER PART 802 THAT
- 14 CERTIFIES THAT THE INDIVIDUAL NAMED IN THE DOCUMENT HAS
- 15 SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED A BOATING SAFETY COURSE AND PASSED AN
- 16 EXAMINATION APPROVED AND ADMINISTERED AS REQUIRED UNDER SECTION
- 17 80211.
- 18 (ii) A DOCUMENT ISSUED BY THE UNITED STATES COAST GUARD
- 19 AUXILIARY OR UNITED STATES POWER SQUADRON THAT CERTIFIES THAT THE
- 20 INDIVIDUAL NAMED IN THE DOCUMENT HAS SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED A
- 21 UNITED STATES COAST GUARD AUXILIARY COURSE CONCERNING BOATING
- 22 SAFETY.
- 23 (iii) A WRITTEN RENTAL AGREEMENT PROVIDED TO AN INDIVIDUAL NAMED
- 24 IN THE RENTAL AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO UNDER SECTION 44522 ONLY ON
- 25 THE DATE OR DATES INDICATED ON THE RENTAL AGREEMENT WHILE THE NAMED
- 26 INDIVIDUAL IS OPERATING A PERSONAL WATERCRAFT LEASED, HIRED, OR
- 27 RENTED FROM A BOAT LIVERY.

- 1 (G) "BOATING SAFETY COURSE" MEANS A COURSE THAT MEETS BOTH OF
- 2 THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:
- 3 (i) PROVIDES INSTRUCTION ON THE SAFE OPERATION OF A PERSONAL
- 4 WATERCRAFT THAT MEETS OR EXCEEDS THE MINIMUM COURSE CONTENT FOR
- 5 BOATING OR PERSONAL WATERCRAFT EDUCATION ESTABLISHED BY THE
- 6 NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF STATE BOATING LAW ADMINISTRATORS EDUCATION
- 7 COMMITTEE (OCTOBER 1996).
- 8 (ii) IS APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT.
- 9 (H) (f) "Controlled substance" means that term as defined in
- 10 section 7104 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.7104.
- 11 (I) (g) "Conviction" means a final conviction, the payment of
- 12 a fine, a plea of guilty or nolo contendere if accepted by the
- 13 court, a finding of guilt, or a probate court OR FAMILY DIVISION
- 14 disposition on a violation of this part, regardless of whether the
- 15 penalty is rebated or suspended.
- Sec. 80104. As used in this part:
- 17 (a) "Highly restricted personal information" means an
- 18 individual's photograph or image, social security number, digitized
- 19 signature, and medical and disability information.
- 20 (b) "Passenger" means a person carried on board a vessel other
- 21 than any of the following:
- (i) The owner or his or her representative.
- (ii) The operator.
- 24 (c) "Peace officer" means any of the following:
- (i) A sheriff.
- 26 (ii) A sheriff's deputy.
- 27 (iii) A deputy who is authorized by a sheriff to enforce this

- 1 part and who has satisfactorily completed at least 40 hours of law
- 2 enforcement training, including training specific to this part.
- 3 (iv) A village or township marshal.
- 4 (v) An officer of the police department of any municipality.
- 5 (vi) An officer of the Michigan state police.
- (vii) The director and conservation officers employed by the
- 7 department.
- 8 (d) "Personal information" means information that identifies
- 9 an individual, including an individual's driver identification
- 10 number, name, address not including zip code, and telephone number,
- 11 but does not include information on watercraft operation and
- 12 equipment-related violations or civil infractions, operator or
- 13 vehicle registration status, accidents, or other behaviorally-
- 14 related information.
- (e) "Personal watercraft" means a vessel that meets all of the
- 16 following requirements:
- 17 (i) Uses a motor-driven propeller or an internal combustion
- 18 engine powering a water jet pump as its primary source of
- 19 propulsion.
- 20 (ii) Is designed without an open load carrying area that would
- 21 retain water.
- 22 (iii) Is designed to be operated by 1 or more persons positioned
- 23 on, rather than within, the confines of the hull.
- 24 (f) "Political subdivision" means any county, metropolitan
- 25 authority, municipality, or combination of those entities in this
- 26 state. Whenever a body of water is located in more than 1 political
- 27 subdivision, all of the subdivisions shall act individually in

- 1 order to comply with this part, except that if the problem is
- 2 confined to a specific area of the body of water, only the
- 3 political subdivision in which the problem waters lie shall act.
- 4 (g) "Port" means left, and reference is to the port side of a
- 5 vessel or to the left side of the vessel.
- 6 (h) "Probate court or family division disposition" means the
- 7 entry of a probate court order of disposition or family division
- 8 order of disposition for a child found to be within the provisions
- 9 of chapter XIIA of the probate code of 1939, 1939 PA 288, MCL
- 10 712A.1 to 712A.32.
- 11 (i) "Prosecuting attorney", except as the context requires
- 12 otherwise, means the attorney general, the prosecuting attorney of
- 13 a county, or the attorney representing a political subdivision of
- 14 government.
- 15 (j) "Regatta", "boat race", "marine parade", "tournament", or
- 16 "exhibition" means an organized water event of limited duration
- 17 that is conducted according to a prearranged schedule.
- 18 (k) "Slow—no wake speed" means a very slow speed whereby the
- 19 wake or wash created by the vessel would be minimal.
- 20 (1) "Starboard" means right, and reference is to the starboard
- 21 side of a vessel or to the right side of the vessel.
- (m) "State aid" means payment made by the state to a county
- 23 for the conduct of a marine safety program.
- (n) "Undocumented vessel" means a vessel that does not have,
- 25 and is not required to have, a valid marine document issued by the
- 26 United States coast guard or federal agency successor to the United
- 27 States coast guard.

- 1 (o) "Uniform inspection decal" means an adhesive-backed
- 2 sticker created by the department that is color-coded to indicate
- 3 the year that it expires and is attached to a vessel in the manner
- 4 prescribed for decals in section 80122 when a peace officer
- 5 inspects and determines that the vessel complies with this part.
- 6 (p) "Use" means operate, navigate, or employ.
- 7 (Q) "WATERCRAFT ENDORSEMENT" MEANS AN ENDORSEMENT AUTHORIZING
- 8 THE HOLDER TO OPERATE WATERCRAFTS UNDER EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 9 (i) THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.1 TO
- 10 257.923.
- 11 (ii) 1972 PA 222, MCL 28.291 TO 28.300.
- (R) (q) "Vessel" means every description of watercraft used or
- 13 capable of being used as a means of transportation on water.
- 14 (S) (r) "Waters of this state" means any waters within the
- 15 territorial limits of this state, and includes those waters of the
- 16 Great Lakes that are under the jurisdiction of this state.
- 17 (T) (s) "Waterways account" means the waterways account of the
- 18 Michigan conservation and recreation legacy fund provided for in
- 19 ESTABLISHED UNDER section 2035.
- 20 Enacting section 1. Section 80215 of the natural resources and
- 21 environmental protection act, 1994 PA 451, MCL 324.80215, is
- 22 repealed.
