

SENATE BILL No. 764

August 26, 2009, Introduced by Senators JELINEK, PAPPAGEORGE and KUIPERS and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled "The code of criminal procedure," by amending section 16a of chapter XVII (MCL 777.16a), as amended by 2004 PA 216.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 CHAPTER XVII

2 Sec. 16a. This chapter applies to the following felonies
