## **SENATE BILL No. 1027**

## December 10, 2009, Introduced by Senators GLEASON, HUNTER, CLARKE, SCOTT, CLARK-COLEMAN, THOMAS, JACOBS, BRATER, PRUSI, CHERRY, OLSHOVE, SWITALSKI and ANDERSON and referred to the Committee on Economic Development and Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1956 PA 218, entitled

"The insurance code of 1956,"

(MCL 500.100 to 500.8302) by adding section 203.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 203. A PERSON WHO HOLDS THE OFFICE OF COMMISSIONER SHALL NOT MAKE EXPENDITURES FOR, RECEIVE COMPENSATION FOR LOBBYING FROM, OR BE EMPLOYED BY ANY OF THE FOLLOWING FOR 2 YEARS AFTER LEAVING THE OFFICE OF COMMISSIONER:

(A) AN INSURER OR OTHER ENTITY REGULATED UNDER THIS ACT.

(B) A NONPROFIT HEALTH CARE CORPORATION REGULATED UNDER THE NONPROFIT HEALTH CARE CORPORATION REFORM ACT, 1980 PA 350, MCL 550.1101 TO 550.1704.

(C) A THIRD PARTY ADMINISTRATOR REGULATED UNDER THE THIRD
