

SENATE BILL No. 1365

June 2, 2010, Introduced by Senators WHITMER, PRUSI, JACOBS, BRATER, CLARK-COLEMAN, BASHAM, SWITALSKI, CHERRY, BARCIA, HUNTER and ANDERSON and referred to the Committee on Campaign and Election Oversight.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 388, entitled
"Michigan campaign finance act,"
(MCL 169.201 to 169.282) by adding section 55e.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 55E. A PERSON THAT KNOWINGLY VIOLATES SECTION 55A, 55B,
2 55C, OR 55D IS GUILTY OF A FELONY PUNISHABLE, IF THE PERSON IS AN
3 INDIVIDUAL, BY A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$5,000.00 OR IMPRISONMENT
4 FOR NOT MORE THAN 3 YEARS, OR BOTH, OR, IF THE PERSON IS NOT AN
5 INDIVIDUAL, BY A FINE OF TRIPLE THE AMOUNT OF THE INDEPENDENT
6 EXPENDITURE THAT VIOLATED SECTION 55A, 55B, 55C, OR 55D.

7 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
8 unless all of the following bills of the 95th Legislature are
9 enacted into law:
