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DEPARTMENT OF LICENSING AND REGULATORY AFFAIRS

- 3 Sec. 251. Funds remaining in the homeowner construction lien
- 4 recovery fund are appropriated to the department of licensing and

 breakwall at the Grand Marais harbor according to a plan to be
 prepared by Burt Township. The project has an estimated completion
