HOUSE BILL No. 4728

June 9, 2011, Introduced by Reps. Santana, Ananich and Barnett and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code," by amending section 648 (MCL 257.648).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 648. (1) The driver OPERATOR of a vehicle or bicycle upon a highway, before stopping or turning from a direct line, shall first see DETERMINE that the stopping or turning can be made in safety and shall give a signal as required in this section.

(2) A—EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (5), A signal required in—UNDER this section shall be given either by means of the hand and arm in the manner specified in this section, or by a mechanical or electrical signal device which—THAT conveys an intelligible signal or warning to other highway traffic. , except
