

HOUSE BILL No. 5540

April 18, 2012, Introduced by Rep. Lund and referred to the Committee on Redistricting and Elections.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled
"Michigan election law,"
by amending section 591 (MCL 168.591), as amended by 1990 PA 109.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 591. (1) Except as provided in **SUBSECTION (2) AND** section
2 532, the state convention of all political parties for the
3 nomination of candidates for state offices in the even numbered
4 years shall commence not less than 60 days before the general
5 November election. The date, time, and location of the state
6 convention shall be designated by the state central committees of
7 the various political parties in their call for a state convention.
8 The calls shall be issued at least 60 days before the August
9 primaries.

10 (2) **IN 2012 ONLY, THE STATE CONVENTION OF ALL POLITICAL**

1 PARTIES FOR THE NOMINATION OF CANDIDATES FOR STATE OFFICES SHALL
2 COMMENCE NOT LESS THAN 58 DAYS BEFORE THE GENERAL NOVEMBER
3 ELECTION.
