## SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4021

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

by amending section 349 (MCL 750.349), as amended by 2006 PA 159.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 349. (1) A person commits the crime of kidnapping if he
- 2 or she knowingly restrains another person with the intent to do 1
- 3 or more of the following:
- 4 (a) Hold that person for ransom or reward.
- 5 (b) Use that person as a shield or hostage.
- 6 (c) Engage in criminal sexual penetration or criminal sexual
- 7 contact PROHIBITED UNDER CHAPTER LXXVI with that person.
- 8 (d) Take that person outside of this state.
- 9 (e) Hold that person in involuntary servitude.
- 10 (F) ENGAGE IN CHILD SEXUALLY ABUSIVE ACTIVITY, AS THAT TERM IS

- 1 DEFINED IN SECTION 145C, WITH THAT PERSON, IF THAT PERSON IS A
- 2 MINOR.
- 3 (2) As used in this section, "restrain" means to restrict a
- 4 person's movements or to confine the person so as to interfere with
- 5 that person's liberty without that person's consent or without
- 6 legal authority. The restraint does not have to exist for any
- 7 particular length of time and may be related or incidental to the
- 8 commission of other criminal acts.
- 9 (3) A person who commits the crime of kidnapping is guilty of
- 10 a felony punishable by imprisonment for life or any term of years
- or a fine of not more than \$50,000.00, or both.
- 12 (4) This section does not prohibit the person from being
- 13 charged with, convicted of, or sentenced for any other violation of
- 14 law arising from the same transaction as the violation of this
- 15 section.
- 16 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 17 after the date it is enacted into law.
