

# HOUSE BILL No. 4606

April 23, 2013, Introduced by Rep. Haines and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1939 PA 288, entitled  
"Probate code of 1939,"  
(MCL 710.21 to 712A.32) by adding section 2f to chapter XIIA.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

CHAPTER XIIA

2           SEC. 2F. WHEN A JUVENILE IS DETERMINED TO BE WITHIN THE  
3 JURISDICTION OF THE COURT UNDER SECTION 2(A)(4) OF THIS CHAPTER DUE  
4 TO WILLFUL AND REPEATED ABSENCE FROM SCHOOL OR ANOTHER LEARNING  
5 PROGRAM, THE COURT SHALL, IMMEDIATELY AFTER ENTRY OF A COURT ORDER  
6 OF DISPOSITION FOR THE JUVENILE, PREPARE AND FORWARD AN ABSTRACT OF  
7 THE RECORD OF THE COURT FOR THE CASE TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE.  
8 UPON RECEIPT OF THE ABSTRACT OF THE RECORD, THE SECRETARY OF STATE  
9 SHALL SUSPEND THE OPERATOR'S LICENSE OF THE JUVENILE FOR 6 MONTHS  
10 FROM THE DATE OF DISPOSITION OR, IN THE CASE OF A JUVENILE WHO IS

1 NOT LICENSED UNDER THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE, 1949 PA 300, MCL  
2 257.1 TO 257.923, THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL NOT ISSUE THE  
3 JUVENILE AN OPERATOR'S LICENSE FOR 6 MONTHS FROM THE DATE OF  
4 DISPOSITION, AS APPLICABLE.

5 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect  
6 unless Senate Bill No. \_\_\_\_\_ or House Bill No. 4607 (request no.  
7 00841'13) of the 97th Legislature is enacted into law.
