(MCL 722.111 to 722.128) by adding section 3h.

- 1 SEC. 3H. (1) ALL CHILD CARE CENTERS, GROUP CHILD CARE HOMES,
- 2 AND FAMILY CHILD CARE HOMES THAT PROVIDE CARE FOR CHILDREN UNDER 1
- 3 YEAR OF AGE MUST IMPLEMENT AND MAINTAIN A WRITTEN SAFE SLEEP POLICY
- 4 THAT IS IN ACCORDANCE WITH APPLICABLE LICENSING RULES PROMULGATED
- 5 UNDER THIS ACT.
 - (2) LICENSEES, REGISTRANTS, AND EMPLOYEES OF CHILD CARE
