

HOUSE BILL No. 5924

November 6, 2014, Introduced by Rep. Daley and referred to the Committee on Tax Policy.

A bill to amend 1972 PA 239, entitled
"McCauley-Traxler-Law-Bowman-McNeely lottery act,"
(MCL 432.1 to 432.47) by adding section 32b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 32B. (1) IF THE BUREAU IS REQUIRED TO WITHHOLD FEDERAL OR
2 STATE INCOME TAXES FROM A PRIZE AND IF THE WINNER OF THE PRIZE
3 RESIDES IN A CITY THAT HAS ADOPTED AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A TAX ON
4 THE INCOME OF RESIDENTS UNDER THE CITY INCOME TAX ACT, 1964 PA 284,
5 MCL 141.501 TO 141.787, THE BUREAU SHALL WITHHOLD FROM THE PRIZE AN
6 AMOUNT COMPUTED BY APPLYING THE RATE SET BY THE CITY ORDINANCE TO
7 BE LEVIED ON THE INCOME OF RESIDENTS AT THE TIME THE PRIZE WAS WON.
8 (2) THE BUREAU SHALL IMMEDIATELY TRANSFER THE AMOUNT WITHHELD
9 UNDER SUBSECTION (1) TO THE CITY.
