Whereas, There are more than 350 intercollegiate wrestling programs in the United States; and

Whereas, Wrestling represents the determination and hard work it takes to succeed in life and sports; and

Whereas, The United States has a long, proud and storied Olympic wrestling history; and Whereas, Wrestling epitomizes the spirit of the Olympic Games; now, therefore, be it Resolved, by the House of Representatives, That the members of this legislative body declare May 2013 as Wrestling Month in the state of Michigan.
