

# HOUSE BILL No. 5027

October 27, 2015, Introduced by Reps. Runestad, Hooker, McBroom, Barrett, Tedder, Glenn, Chatfield, Aaron Miller, Lucido and Franz and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled  
"The code of criminal procedure,"  
by amending section 12c of chapter XVII (MCL 777.12c), as added  
by 2002 PA 34.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

### CHAPTER XVII

Sec. 12c. This chapter applies to the following felonies  
enumerated in chapters I and II of the Michigan vehicle code,  
1949 PA 300, within chapter 257 of the Michigan Compiled Laws **AND**  
**TO THE FOLLOWING FELONIES ENUMERATED IN CHAPTER 259 OF THE**  
**MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS:**
