

HOUSE BILL No. 5200

December 17, 2015, Introduced by Reps. Chatfield, Johnson, Aaron Miller, Bumstead and Cole and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 372, entitled

"An act to regulate and license the selling, purchasing, possessing, and carrying of certain firearms, gas ejecting devices, and electro-muscular disruption devices; to prohibit the buying, selling, or carrying of certain firearms, gas ejecting devices, and electro-muscular disruption devices without a license or other authorization; to provide for the forfeiture of firearms and electro-muscular disruption devices under certain circumstances; to provide for penalties and remedies; to provide immunity from civil liability under certain circumstances; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local agencies; to prohibit certain conduct against individuals who apply for or receive a license to carry a concealed pistol; to make appropriations; to prescribe certain conditions for the appropriations; and to repeal all acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act,"

by amending section 5c (MCL 28.425c), as amended by 2015 PA 3; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 5c. (1) A license to carry a concealed pistol shall be in
2 a form, with the same dimensions as a Michigan operator license,
3 prescribed by the department of state police. Beginning December 1,

1 2015, the license shall be constructed of plastic laminated paper
2 or hard plastic. No additional fee shall be charged for the license
3 unless otherwise prescribed in this act. A fee not to exceed \$10.00
4 may be charged for an optional hard plastic license only if the
5 county clerk also provides the option of obtaining a plastic
6 laminated paper license at no charge. A county clerk shall deposit
7 a fee collected under this subsection in the concealed pistol
8 licensing fund of that county created in section 5x. The license
9 shall contain all of the following:

10 (a) The licensee's full name and date of birth.

11 (b) A photograph and a physical description of the licensee.

12 (c) A statement of the effective dates of the license.

13 (d) An indication of exceptions authorized by this act
14 applicable to the licensee.

15 (e) The licensee's state-issued driver license or personal
16 identification card number.

17 ~~—(f) The premises on which carrying a concealed pistol is~~

19 (F) ~~(g)~~—The peace officer disclosure required under section
20 5f(3).

21 (G) ~~(h)~~—An indication whether the license is a duplicate or an
22 emergency license.

23 (H) ~~(i)~~—If the license is an emergency license, an indication
24 that the emergency license does not exempt the individual from
25 complying with all applicable laws for the purchase of firearms.

26 (2) The department of state police or a county clerk shall not
27 require a licensee's signature to appear on a license to carry a

2 (3) ~~Subject to section 5o and except~~ **EXCEPT** as otherwise
3 provided by law, a license to carry a concealed pistol issued by
4 the county clerk authorizes the licensee to do all of the
5 following:

6 (a) Carry a pistol concealed on or about his or her person
7 anywhere in this state.

8 (b) Carry a pistol in a vehicle, whether concealed or not
9 concealed, anywhere in this state.

10 (4) The secretary of state shall make a digitized photograph
11 taken of the applicant for a driver license or personal
12 identification card available to the department for use under this
13 act. The department shall provide the photograph of the applicant
14 received from the secretary of state to the county clerk who shall
15 use the photograph on the individual's license unless the applicant
16 does not have a digitized photograph on file with the secretary of
17 state. If an applicant does not have a digitized photograph on file
18 with the secretary of state, the applicant shall provide a
19 passport-quality photograph of the applicant as provided under
20 section 5b(1).

21 Enacting section 1. Section 5o of 1927 PA 372, MCL 28.425o, is
22 repealed effective 90 days after the date this amendatory act is
23 enacted into law.

24 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
25 after the date it is enacted into law.
