

HOUSE BILL No. 5442

March 9, 2016, Introduced by Rep. Iden and referred to the Committee on Communications and Technology.

A bill to prescribe the active shooter alert system as the official response to active shooter situations in this state; and to provide for the powers and duties of certain state and local governmental officers and authorities.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
2 "active shooter alert system act".

3 Sec. 2. (1) The department of state police shall establish and
4 maintain the active shooter alert system plan.

5 (2) The active shooter alert system plan shall be designed to
6 rapidly disseminate useful information in a predetermined manner to
7 radio and televisions stations within this state and to send text
8 messages to wireless 2-way communication devices, including
9 cellular telephones.

1 Sec. 3. The active shooter alert system plan shall be
2 activated only in accordance with the policies established by the
3 department of state police.

4 Enacting section 1. This act takes effect 90 days after the
5 date it is enacted into law.
