- 1 SEC. 81F. (1) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, A
- 2 PERSON WHO ASSAULTS OR ASSAULTS AND BATTERS AN INDIVIDUAL WITH A
- 3 DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITY AND WHO KNOWS THE INDIVIDUAL HAS A
- 4 DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITY IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY
- 5 IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN
- 6 \$1,000.00, OR BOTH.
- 7 (2) A PERSON WHO COMMITS AN ASSAULT OR AN ASSAULT AND BATTERY
- 8 IN VIOLATION OF SUBSECTION (1) AND WHO HAS 1 OR MORE PREVIOUS
- 9 CONVICTIONS FOR VIOLATING SUBSECTION (1) OR AN ORDINANCE OF A
