A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1160.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 1160. BEGINNING IN THE 2016-2017 SCHOOL YEAR, THE BOARD
- 2 OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT OR BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF A PUBLIC SCHOOL
- 3 ACADEMY THAT OPERATES AN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL SHALL ENSURE THAT ALL OF
- 4 THE FOLLOWING ARE MET WITH RESPECT TO MUSIC INSTRUCTION FOR PUPILS
- 5 IN GRADES K TO 5:
- 6 (A) THAT EACH PUPIL IN GRADES K TO 5 IS PROVIDED WITH AT LEAST
- 7 2 CLASS PERIODS PER WEEK OF INSTRUCTION IN MUSIC, CONSISTING OF AT
- 8 LEAST 30 MINUTES EACH CLASS PERIOD.
- 9 (B) THAT EACH CLASS PROVIDED UNDER SUBDIVISION (A) IS TAUGHT
- 10 BY A CERTIFICATED TEACHER WITH A JX OR JQ ENDORSEMENT ISSUED BY THE
- 11 DEPARTMENT.

- 1 (C) THAT THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY HAS AT
- 2 LEAST 1 CERTIFICATED MUSIC TEACHER WITH A JX OR JQ ENDORSEMENT
- 3 ISSUED BY THE DEPARTMENT FOR EACH 400 PUPILS ENROLLED IN GRADES K
- 4 TO 5 IN THAT SCHOOL DISTRICT OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY.
- 5 (D) THAT THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY HAS
- 6 ADOPTED AND IMPLEMENTED A MUSIC CURRICULUM CONSISTENT WITH STATE

- 8 (E) THAT EACH ELEMENTARY SCHOOL BUILDING OPERATED BY THE

- 11 (F) THAT THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY
- 12 ESTABLISHES AND MAINTAINS AN APPROPRIATE BUDGET FOR ELEMENTARY
- 13 MUSIC INSTRUCTION.
- 14 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 15 after the date it is enacted into law.
