

SENATE BILL No. 1027

June 9, 2016, Introduced by Senators HERTEL, JONES, KNEZEK, HUNE, O'BRIEN, SCHMIDT, ANANICH, YOUNG, MACGREGOR, SCHUITMAKER and KOWALL and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 295, entitled "Sex offenders registration act," by amending section 34 (MCL 28.734), as amended by 2005 PA 322.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 34. (1) Except as provided in this section and section
2 36, an individual required to be registered under article II shall
3 not do 1 or more of the following:

4 (a) Work within a student safety zone.

5 (b) Loiter within a student safety zone.

6 (c) **WORK AT OR VOLUNTEER FOR AN ORGANIZATION THAT WORKS WITH**
7 **INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE LESS THAN 18 YEARS OF AGE OR VICTIMS OF SEXUAL**
8 **ASSAULT.**

9 (2) An individual who violates this section is guilty of a
10 crime as follows:

11 (a) For the first violation, the individual is guilty of a

1 misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 1 year or
2 a fine of not more than \$1,000.00, or both.

3 (b) An individual who violates this section and has 1 or more
4 prior convictions under this section is guilty of a felony
5 punishable by imprisonment for not more than 2 years or a fine of
6 not more than \$2,000.00, or both.

7 (3) Subsection (1)(a) does not apply to any of the following:

8 (a) An individual who was working within a student safety zone
9 on January 1, 2006. However, this exception does not apply to an
10 individual who initiates or maintains contact with a minor within
11 that student safety zone.

12 (b) An individual whose place of employment is within a
13 student safety zone solely because a school is relocated or is
14 initially established 1,000 feet or less from the individual's
15 place of employment. However, this exception does not apply to an
16 individual who initiates or maintains contact with a minor within
17 that student safety zone.

18 (c) An individual who only intermittently or sporadically
19 enters a student safety zone for the purpose of work. However, this
20 exception does not apply to an individual who initiates or
21 maintains contact with a minor within a student safety zone.

22 (4) This section does not prohibit an individual from being
23 charged with, convicted of, or punished for any other violation of
24 law that is committed by that individual while violating this
25 section.

26 (5) Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit an
27 individual from exercising his or her right to vote.

1 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
2 after the date it is enacted into law.
