**CONTENT**

The bill would amend the Michigan Memorial Highway Act to designate the portion of highway M-13 in Bay County as the "PFC Alan Robert Blohm Memorial Highway".

The bill would take effect 90 days after it was enacted.

**BACKGROUND**

PFC Alan Robert Blohm died at the age of 21 on December 31, 2006, after being wounded during his deployment in Iraq. He attended and graduated from Bay City Western High School. PFC Blohm joined the United States Army in September 2005 while living in Alaska. He was deployed to Iraq on October 1, 2006, as a member of the 425<sup>th</sup> Brigade Special Troops Battalion, 4<sup>th</sup> Airborne Brigade Combat Team, 25<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division, and was stationed near Baghdad.
