

# HOUSE BILL No. 6153

June 12, 2018, Introduced by Reps. Rendon and Allor and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 702 (MCL 324.702), as added by 1995 PA 60; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           Sec. 702. The department shall do all of the following:

2           ~~— (a) Administer a grant and loan program pursuant to sections~~

4           **(A)** ~~(b)~~ Provide advice and recommendations to the legislature,  
5           the governor, and executive departments ~~in order~~ to promote the  
6           development of the forestry and forest products industry and the  
7           mineral extraction and utilization industry in this state.

8           **(B)** ~~(e)~~ Develop programs and coordinate existing and proposed

6 (C) ~~(e)~~—Review existing laws and regulations pertaining to  
7 forestry and the mineral industry and develop proposals for new  
8 laws or changes in existing law to improve this state's forest and  
9 mineral resource development as considered appropriate by the  
10 department.

11 (D) ~~(f)~~—Promote and provide for educational programs for the  
12 general public and members of local government to increase  
13 awareness of the importance of the forestry and forest products  
14 industry and the mineral industry to this state.

15 (E) ~~(g)~~—Consult with representatives of science, industry,  
16 labor, government, and other groups and utilize the services of  
17 public and private organizations, including colleges and  
18 universities, as the department considers necessary or helpful **IN**  
19 **THE DISCHARGE OF ITS DUTIES UNDER SUBDIVISIONS (A) TO (D).**

20 Enacting section 1. Sections 701, 703, 704, and 705 of the  
21 natural resources and environmental protection act, 1994 PA 451,  
22 MCL 324.701, 324.703, 324.704, and 324.705, are repealed.

23 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days  
24 after the date it is enacted into law.
